



REGULATIONS FOR PRESS / PHOTO / TV ACCREDITATION IN ROK WINTER TROPHY 2026 EVENT

MEDIA GUIDE

The Press-Media/Photographer/TV Operator accreditation has to be requested on behalf of a newspaper, professional agency or website. The headquarters, VAT identification number and address of the newspaper or agency must be specified. All the personal data (address, phone number, e-mail) of the person that is to be accredited as press/photographer must also be specified. Each photographic agency is entitled to accreditate up to two persons with access to the track. Journalists and photographers must send the motivation for their service to the e-mail: info@vortex-rok.com.

Otk Kart Group Srl is the owner of the rights for all the images of its events.

Accredited journalists and news correspondents are entitled to use the Press Office (until the limit allowed) within the Paddock, but they cannot access the track, the pre-grid area and Park Ferme.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

The accredited photographers will be given a ROK identification bib. They can access Press Office (until the limit allowed) and the Paddock, the circuit and pre-grid. They cannot stay in Park Ferme. In case of necessity, they are allowed to go through Park Ferme to access the circuit, but they must not stop or take pictures while in Park Ferme. Photographers are compulsorily required to own a personal insurance covering all the risks connected to the professional activity in motorsport events, and an insurance covering the civil liability for damages caused to third parties. It is preferable that accredited photographers are members of a Professional Order. Freelance photographers without professional profiles will not be accepted.

The photographers complying with the above-mentioned requisites (VAT identification number, Insurance covering the risks and Civil liability) can be accredited also by the participating Teams. In this case, the requests will be evaluated by ROK staff.

Photographers must not stop in the red areas marked on the map of the circuits. It is forbidden to stay in the main straight for the first two laps of each race and photographers must position themselves in safe places during the last lap.

USAGE OF DRONES

The use of drones is strictly forbidden at all times in the whole circuit, unless otherwise specified, in writing, by the Race Director, who will also describe the specific moments in which drones could be used and the most suitable areas.

Only a limited number of track access passes are available and this number is decided by the Organizer. The following documentation has to be provided to obtain the accreditation:

- A copy of the Professional Insurance covering all the risks connected to the professional activity in motorsport events with extension for karting/racing track.
- A copy of the Professional Insurance covering civil liability for damages caused to third parties and property.
- Photo ID.
- Disclaimer and indemnity agreement for press officers and photographers accessing the karting track required by South Garda Karting, completed and signed.

GIVEN THAT:

- The company So.fin.pa. srl (hereinafter referred to as the “Company”) manages the karting track located in Lonato del Garda (BS) called South Garda Karting;
- The undersigned intends to access the facility as a press officer/photographer to document the sporting event called _____ on _____;
- Access to the circuit areas involves specific risks associated with the presence of vehicles traveling at high speed;

DECLARES TO BE AWARE THAT/ UNDERTAKES TO:

Art.1- Professional qualification and purpose of access

The undersigned declares that he/she is a professional journalist/publicist/photographer duly registered with the Order and that he/she is accessing the circuit exclusively for the purpose of carrying out journalistic information and documentation activities, in compliance with the ethical rules of the profession and Article 21 of the Constitution on freedom of the press.

Art. 2 - Awareness of specific environmental risks

The undersigned declares that they are fully aware that access to the karting track areas involves specific and intrinsic risks, including but not limited to:

The presence of vehicles traveling at high speed;

The possibility of vehicles leaving the track, collisions, and debris being thrown;

High noise levels and the presence of exhaust fumes;

Slippery surfaces and the presence of oily materials;

Risks arising from weather conditions;

The possibility of mechanical malfunctions of vehicles;

Falling objects or vehicle parts.

Art. 3 - Compliance with safety requirements

The undersigned strictly undertakes to:

Scrupulously comply with all instructions provided by Company personnel and race officials;

Access only areas authorized and marked as accessible to press personnel;

Use any personal protective equipment provided or required;

Maintain the utmost attention and caution at all times while on the premises;

Not interfere in any way with the sporting event;

Immediately report any dangerous situations to staff;

Not access the track or service areas without specific authorization;

Comply with the prohibitions on access to restricted areas highlighted on the map received.

Art. 4 - Professional insurance

The undersigned declares that he/she has valid professional insurance for third-party liability expiring on _____ with a maximum coverage of € _____, specifically extended to access to motor racing/karting circuits, and accident insurance expiring on _____, and undertakes to produce the relevant documentation on request.

Art. 5 - EXEMPTION FROM:

Within the limits permitted by law and with specific reference to the normal and foreseeable risks associated with being in a motorsport environment, the undersigned exempts the Company, its employees, collaborators, agents, and the organizers of the event from any liability for damage to persons or property resulting from: Risks typical and inherent in motorsport activities;

- Fortuitous or unforeseeable events not attributable to the Company;
- Reckless or negligent conduct of participants or third parties;
- Sudden and unforeseeable malfunctions of the vehicles in the race.

Art.6 - INDEMNITY

The undersigned undertakes to indemnify and hold harmless the Company from any claim for compensation, legal action or claim made by third parties for damage caused by their professional activity or conduct while on the premises.

Art.7-Processing of personal data and right to report

The undersigned authorizes the processing of their personal data for purposes related to access and declares that they will operate in compliance with privacy regulations in the exercise of the right to report, in accordance with the rules of professional conduct for journalistic activities.

Art.8 - Time validity

This release is valid exclusively for the event of _____ and automatically expires at the end of the same.

Art. 9 - Jurisdiction

The Court of Brescia shall have jurisdiction over any disputes.

The undersigned declares that they have read, understood, and fully accepted this document, that they have viewed and printed the map of the circuit indicating the areas prohibited to press personnel, and that they have been informed of the specific risks of the environment and the safety regulations to be observed.
